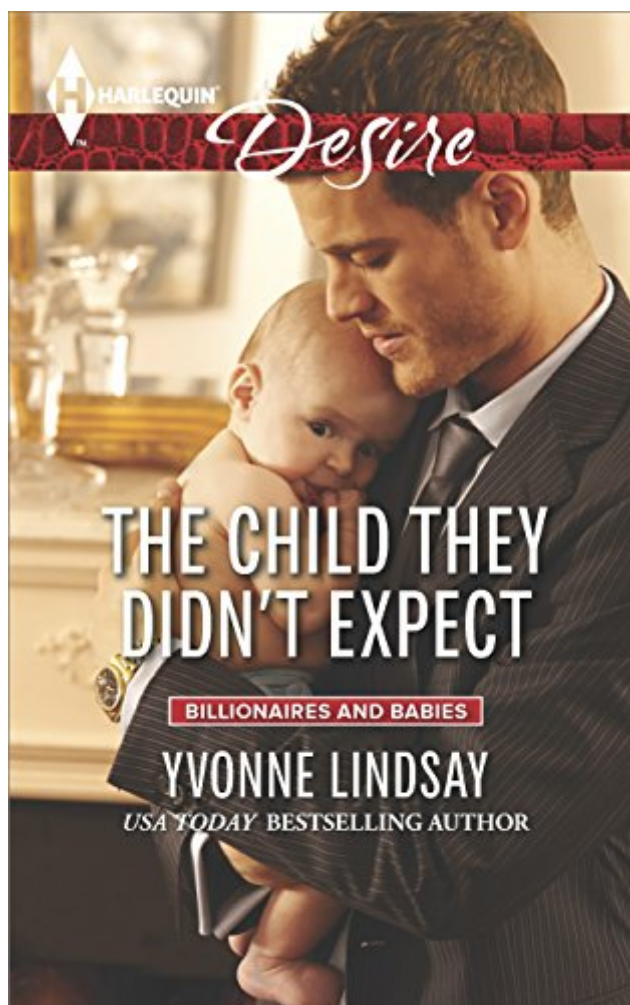


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The Child They Didn't Expect (Billionaires And Babies)

This book is a tear-jerker. Ali, heroine, can't have children, but desperately wanted them. Her husband, Richard, cheats on her with his interior decorator. He divorces her to marry his lover. (Please read the other reviews for more in-depth summaries on storyline.) She starts a business called Best For Baby. Ronin, hero, hires her after his sister and her husband are killed in a car accident (while on the way to the hospital because she is in labor) to help prepare his home for their baby, Joshua. Spoiler: His brother-in-law is Ali's ex-husband, Richard, nka R.J. His sister, CeeCee

is obviously the "other woman". How awkward. Can you imagine Sunday dinners and holidays when they all get together? When Ronin and his parents talk about how much they miss CeeCee and R.J. or when Joshua asks about his parents, what is Ali supposed to say? R.J. was a major a-hole and CeeCee is a home wrecker. Maybe she ought to say, "I hope they burn in hell, please pass the potatoes." Ya' think? That would go over well. I just have a hard time imagining any level of comfort for any of the parties involved. Would I recommend this book? It's hard to say.
